Walking Up the Mountain of God: *The Symbolism of Moses' Tabernacle in the Wilderness*

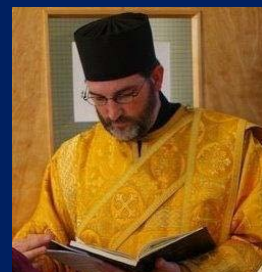

This sanctuary, which accompanied God's People in the wilderness for 40 years, was the dwelling place of God in their midst, and a place of prayer, worship and ministry for the priests of Israel.

Both Jews and Christians over the centuries have seen in this holy tabernacle and its mysterious rites, and furnishings, such as the Ark of the Covenant and Lampstand, signs of God's plan of salvation.
